SCOPE OF THE PROJECT

The Jubail Chemical Plant project is run by a Joint Venture partnership, Baker Petrolite Saudi Co. Ltd, and consists of the GM of Investment Development for the Royal Commission for Jubail and Yanbu, and the Baker Hughes Real Estate Management Team. The project brief was to build a new chemical plant including all of the general offices and infrastructure type facilities.

Due to an existing long-term relationship between Addison Project and Baker Hughes UK, Addison supported the project from 2020 providing initially providing Process and Project Management support on a predominantly remote basis to the site based team in Jubail.



HIGHLIGHTS

- Project Management of a large international construction project applying best practice and professional management.
- Construction Management of locally appointed trades ensuring high standards are applied in line with UK legislation and safe systems of work.

During January 2023, whilst gearing up for peak construction activities on site, Baker Hughes contacted Addison and requested additional resources and project governance to ensure best practices were being applied and the project was being managed as effectively as possible. Addison presence immediately increased to 2 people on site providing both Project Management and Construction Management support. Latterly the project scope also increased to include part time Planning support and Project Engineering support.

- Presentation of a monthly summary report to the JV with a health check of the project main KPIs – Quality, Time and Cost.
